Conflict Resolution**Presenter: Dave Holland, Wasatch Safety**

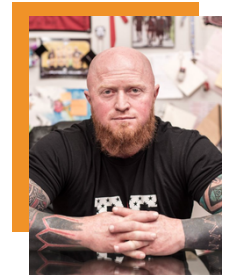
